Notice of Construction

As you may be aware, Pacific Coast Terminals (PCT) received a project permit (PP 2014-096) from the Vancouver Fraser Port Authority to construct a potash handling facility as part of PCT's expansion project. Pacific Coast Terminals is committed to providing the community with updates of construction and its potential impacts throughout the duration of the project.

As a part of our current expansion, PCT has substantially completed the construction of the Potash Handling Facility. The project team is currently commissioning the facility. Minor scopes of work remain in progress, such as installation of the reed shoals and vegetation management. The current project permit expires on September 30, 2017 and PCT has received an extension until December 31, 2017 from the port authority to complete the remaining work.

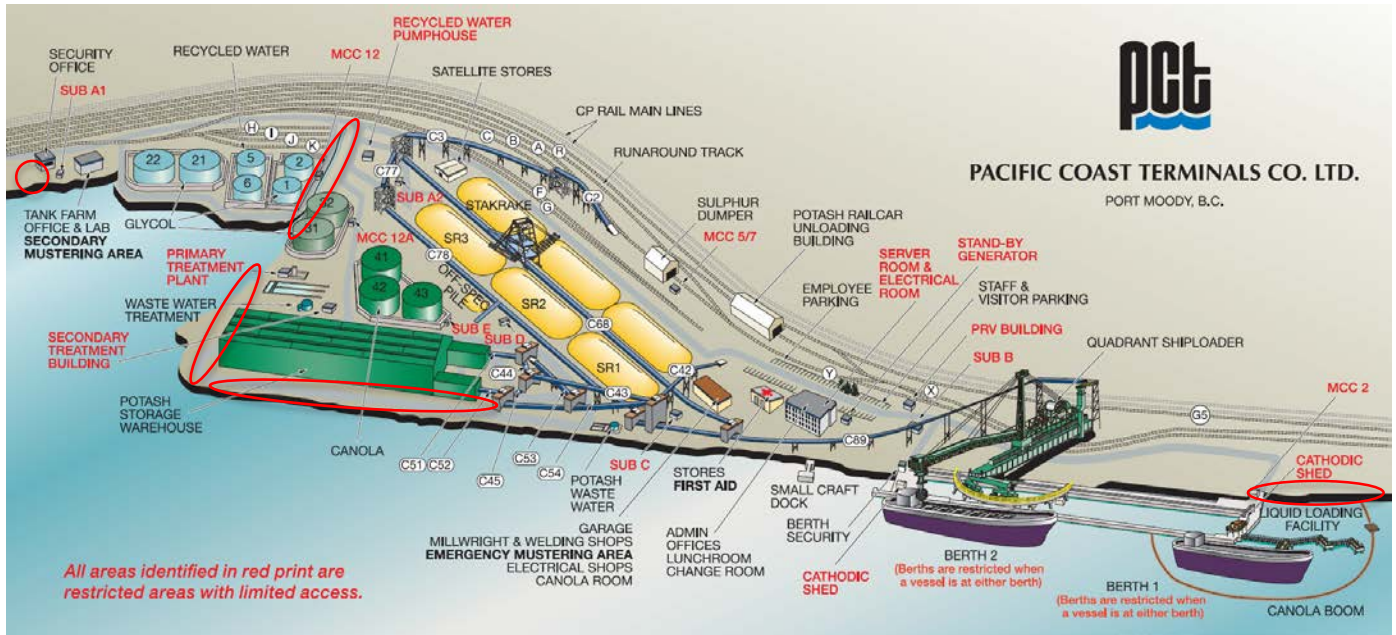
Construction Working Hours
