## **Notice of Construction**

As you may be aware, Pacific Coast Terminals (PCT) has received a project permit (PP 2014-096) from Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA) to construct a potash handling facility as part of PCT's expansion project. Pacific Coast Terminals is committed to providing the community with updates of construction and its potential impacts throughout the duration of the project.

## **Construction Working Hours**

PCT has received approval from Vancouver Fraser Port Authority (VFPA) to extend work hours of construction for the Railcar Unloader Facility by two hours, from 8-10pm, Monday-Saturday from June 1 to August 31, 2016. Scope of works during extended hours are limited to structural welding and grinding inside the previously excavated tunnel. The tunnel is situated approximately 150m northwest of the existing sulfur rail unloading facility, and at the base of the Barnet Highway embankment.

## **Work Site Location**



The potential increment in noise from welding and grinding will be minimal as the existing generator sets, which provide power for continuous safety lighting and for dewatering purposes, will be utilized. Previous sound readings estimate the sound will predictably be lower in the community above the Barnet Hwy due to in part to the highway and the adjacent treed embankment.
