MAINTENANCE WORK

August 13th – August 27th, 2018

Pacific Coast Terminals Co. Ltd. (PCT) wishes to advise our neighbours that we will be performing a maintenance shutdown from August 13th – August 27th.

The terminal's sulphur rail car unloading area, stockpile area, and Berth 2 vessel loading operation, will be shutdown (Berth 1 liquids will remain active as well as potash unloading). There will be a number of projects being completed with the majority of work being concentrated on the sulphur dumper, stakrake, and berthface. Work will be steel construction in nature and will require the use of power tools, welder/generator and work area lighting. We understand the inconvenience to residents, as this may result in having noise and light emitted from our terminal, so we apologize in advance.

These activities are anticipated, in addition to regular work hours, from 8pm-7am, Monday to Sunday.
