Notice of Continuing Marine Berm Construction

Pacific Coast Terminals (PCT) is providing the public an update of continued berm construction activities taking place near the terminal. Berm construction activities will continue after a review and assessment was completed by design engineers. The process will be very similar to what occurred earlier this year, most recently in late August and early September. The Fraser River Pile and Dredge (FRPD) MacKenize derrick, flat scows and a tug will move the equipment to multiple locations along the berm alignment directly in front of PCT in the inlet. From the derrick, the clamshell bucket will place 6 inch-minus core rock to design elevations of 4.5m chart datum.

Working Hours

Marine berm construction will occur over an approximate six (6) week period, from approximately October 17, 2018 to December 3, 2018. No work will be done on Sundays or Statutory holidays (November 11, 2018). Daily activities will take place from 7:00 am to 8 pm consistent within the Port Moody Sound By-law.
