



BERTHAGE

Eight dollars and ten cents (**\$8.10**) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

- (A) When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be ninety-nine cents (**\$0.99**) per meter per hour or part thereof.
- (B) On all days defined as non-working days in the Agreement in force between the International Longshore and Warehouse Union and the British Columbia Maritime Employers Association, the rate shall be four dollars and five cents (**\$4.05**) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or fraction thereof, except that when any portion of an eight (8) hour period occurring either before or at the end of one or more eight hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for such fraction shall be forty-nine cents (**\$0.49**) per meter per hour or part thereof.

GANGWAY

Two hundred and forty-three dollars and thirty-seven cents (**\$243.37**) for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be thirty dollars and forty-two cents (**\$30.42**) per hour or part thereof.

FRESH WATER

Five dollars and ninety cents (**\$5.90**) per one thousand (1,000) kilos.

Hose connections:

One hundred and sixty-six dollars and fifty-one cents (**\$166.51**) per connection.
Includes 100 ft. hose.

Each additional 50 ft. length of hose is thirty-three dollars and seventy-five cents (**\$33.75**)
