



**BERTHAGE**

Eight dollars and forty-eight cents (**\$8.48**) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

- (A) When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be One dollar and four cents (**\$1.04**) per meter per hour or part thereof.
- (B) On all days defined as non-working days in the Agreement in force between the International Longshore and Warehouse Union and the British Columbia Maritime Employers Association, the rate shall be four dollars and twenty four cents (**\$4.24**) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or fraction thereof, except that when any portion of an eight (8) hour period occurring either before or at the end of one or more eight hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for such fraction shall be fifty-one cents (**\$0.51**) per meter per hour or part thereof.

**GANGWAY**

Two hundred and fifty-four dollars and eighty-one cents (**\$254.81**) for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be thirty one dollars and eighty-five cents (**\$31.85**) per hour or part thereof.

**FRESH WATER**

Six dollars and eighteen cents (**\$6.18**) per one thousand (1,000) kilos.

Hose connections:

One hundred and seventy-four dollars and thirty-four cents (**\$174.34**) per connection.  
Includes 100 ft. hose.

Each additional 50 ft. length of hose is thirty-five dollars and thirty-four cents (**\$35.34**)
