



BERTHAGE

Nine dollars and sixty-seven cents (**\$9.67**) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

- (A) When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be One dollar and eighteen cents (**\$1.18**) per meter per hour or part thereof.
- (B) On all days defined as non-working days in the Agreement in force between the International Longshore and Warehouse Union and the British Columbia Maritime Employers Association, the rate shall be four dollars and eighty-two cents (**\$4.82**) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or fraction thereof, except that when any portion of an eight (8) hour period occurring either before or at the end of one or more eight hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for such fraction shall be fifty-eight cents (**\$0.58**) per meter per hour or part thereof.

GANGWAY

Two hundred and ninety dollars and fifty-six cents (**\$290.56**) for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be thirty-six dollars and thirty-two cents (**\$36.32**) per hour or part thereof.

FRESH WATER

Seven dollars and four cents (**\$7.04**) per one thousand (1,000) kilos.

Hose connections:

One hundred and ninety-eight dollars and fifty-three cents (**\$198.53**) per connection.
Includes 100 ft. hose.

Each additional 50 ft. length of hose is forty dollars and twenty-five cents (**\$40.25**)
