



BERTHAGE

Ten dollars and twenty-one cents (**\$10.21**) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

- (A) When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be One dollar and twenty five cents (**\$1.25**) per meter per hour or part thereof.
- (B) On all days defined as non-working days in the Agreement in force between the International Longshore and Warehouse Union and the British Columbia Maritime Employers Association, the rate shall be five dollars and seven cents (**\$5.07**) per meter for each eight (8) consecutive hours or fraction thereof, except that when any portion of an eight (8) hour period occurring either before or at the end of one or more eight hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for such fraction shall be sixty-one cents (**\$0.61**) per meter per hour or part thereof.

GANGWAY

Three hundred and six dollars and eighty-three cents (**\$306.83**) for each eight (8) consecutive hours or part thereof.

When any fraction of any eight (8) hour period remaining at the end of one or more eight (8) hour periods does not exceed four (4) hours, the rate for each fraction shall be thirty-eight dollars and thirty-five cents (**\$38.35**) per hour or part thereof.

FRESH WATER

Seven dollars and forty four cents (**\$7.44**) per one thousand (1,000) kilos.

Hose connections:

Two hundred and nine dollars and thirty-seven cents (**\$209.37**) per connection.
Includes 100 ft. hose.

Each additional 50 ft. length of hose is forty two dollars and forty-seven cents (**\$42.47**)
